

Chicken Granny Square



What a change in the weather. It was still the highest high summer and now: Autumn! And with me, crafting becomes more comfortable again. Cuddly wool sweaters, socks and anything that beautifies the inside. And since we've been overjoyed chicken owners since spring, I'm very keen to crochet a chicken pillow for our sofa. I have written down the instructions for a chicken granny square for you. With the help of a pillow, you can certainly do many other sweet things with it. A pincushion, for example, or an entire blanket, or, or, or



Materials:

Catania 00281 orange, 00115 red, 00151 nature, 00403 vanilla, 00425 bordeaux und 00110 black

Hooksize 2,0 and 3,0 mm

Needle

Scissors

Abbreviations (US):

St - Stitch

R - Row

Rd - Round

Sc - single crochet

Sl st - slip stitch

Ch - chain

Hdc - half double crochet

Dc - double crochet

Tr – treble crochet

Tch - turning chain

Inc – increase

Dec – decrease

Granny-Square

1. Rd: with red and hook size 3; ch 2 (=hdc), 11 hdc in Magic Ring, close with sl st to make a circle (=12 st)

2. Rd: (ch3, dc), 2dc in next stitches (=24 st)

3. Rd: (ch3, dc), dc, (dc, 2dc in same st) repeat. Close R with sl st (=36 st)

4. Rd: (ch3, dc), 2 dc, (2dc, 2dc in same st) repeat. Close R with sl st in first st. (=48 st)

Change color to orange.

5. Rd: 4 sc, 3 hdc, (2 dc), ch, (2 dc), 3 hdc repeat 3x (=60 st)

6. Rd: ch 3 (=dc), dc in every st, in the corners: (2 dc, ch, 2 dc (=78 st)
7. Rd: ch (= sc), sc in every st, in the corners; (sc, ch, sc) (=84 st)

Chicken:

1. R: with nature and hook size 2; ch6, start in second ch from the hook; 5 sc, tch (=5 st)
2. R: inc, 3 sc, inc, tch (=7 st)
3. R: 7 sc, tch (=7 st)
4. R: inc, 5 sc, inc, tch (=9 st)
5. R: 9 sc, tch (=9 st)
6. R: inc, 7 sc, inc, tch (=11 st)
- 7.-8. R: 11 sc, tch (=11 st)
9. R: ch4 (= tr), tr, (dc, hdc), 9 sc, tch (=12 st)
- 10 R: 5 sc, tch (=5 st)
11. R: dec, sc, dec, tch (=3 st)
- 12.-14 R: 3 sc, tch (=3 st)
15. R: dec, sc (=2 st)

Start with a standing ch and crochet sc around the chicken. (2sc in the tail). Fasten off, leaving a yarn tail and sew on the granny square.

Legs (2x):

With Vanilla; ch 8, start in second ch from the hook; 2 sl st, ch3, in second ch from the hook; 2 sl st, in the first st from this chain; 4 sl st.

Fasten off and sew on the granny square.

Cockscomb:

With red ch 4, start in second ch from the hook; (sc, sl st), (sl st, ch, sc, sl st) x2.

Fasten off with longer yarn tail and sew on the head of the chicken on the granny square.

Embroider the throat flaps with red and an eye with black.

Your chicken granny square is ready!



Of course, in this way you can also create a colorful
Crochet chicken gang. With a rooster. A pillow from it just looks great...
